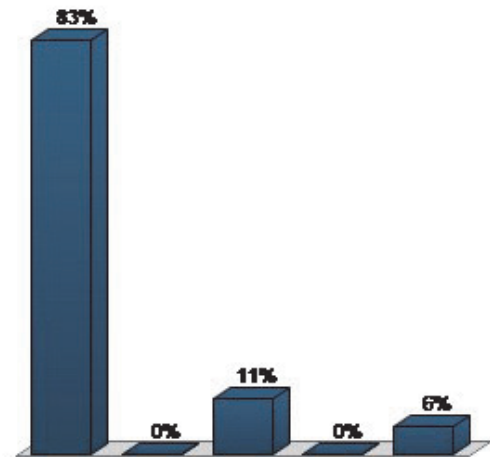
26. Arts and Culture, Project #149: Creative Learning at the Grand Rapids Art Museum (Multiple Choice)
